## FRESHWATER FISH OF THE MONTH SILVER TIP TETRAS

The tetra family has some beautiful fish amongst it and included must be the lovely Silver Tip Tetras. These little fish have a golden body with

black markings on the caudal peduncle and silver tips to



their otherwise clear fins and tail. They make a lovely display when kept with other tetras such as neons, cardinals, black neons or, in fact, any of the small tetras. They also mix readily with most small to medium community fish, as they are quite peaceful. Easy to feed, they will enjoy standard dried and frozen foods. Normally \$4.75

### FRESHWATER PLANT OF THE MONTH – BLUE STRICTA

Blue Stricta is a hardy bunch plant which makes a great backdrop for lower growing plants. It will grow to the top of the water (and above) in



most aquariums and can be pinched out at the top to encourage growth low down. The green colouration will vary from dark to lime according to

lighting conditions. As with most bunch plants, Blue Stricta grows from a cutting. Although it can be planted in a bunch, good results come from it being separated out and pieces planted close together, but individually. Regularly \$6.50 bunch. JANUARY SPECIAL \$5.50

# MARINE FISH OF THE MONTH – COPPERBAND BUTTERFLY

It is perhaps a little unfortunate, that with the popularity of reef tanks, keeping butterfly fish has fallen out of favour somewhat. The butterfly family has some of the most colourful

and beautiful of marine fish but, as in the majority of cases they will



eat live coral, they cannot be kept in reef tanks. An exception to this is the Copperband Butterfly (Chelmon Rostratus) which is <u>usually</u> safe with most corals although it has been known to have an occasional nibble. Why would you then risk having one in your reef tank? Quite simply they are one of the best aiptasia eradicators around. Aiptasia are pest



anemones which multiply at an alarming rate and will

overgrow and smother live corals and inverts. Copperbands will use their long pointed 'nose' to pluck aiptasia from the most inaccessible places and eat them with relish.

Copperbands generally mix well with other fish but can be territorial with other butterflies. They make a lovely addition to 'fish only' tanks but can be fussy feeders if aiptasia are not available to start them off. Try them on fine frozen and live foods or apply a paste of dry food to rock for them to pick at. Regular price \$49.00. THIS MONTH \$44.00.

### FLUVAL SEA 'AQUASKY' AND 'MARINE AND REEF 2.0' LED LIGHTS PLUS NEW! LED LAMP TIMER AND LED WIFI MODULE

Last year we gave you information on



both of the Fluval Sea LED lights. First was the **Aquasky**, an affordable LED recommended for use in freshwater tanks with low to mid light level plants or fish-only salt water tanks.

The Aquasky LED lighting unit comes in three sizes – 18 Watt with 42 LEDs, 27

Watt with 63 LEDs and 35 Watt with 84 LEDs. Each individual LED casts 120° of light dispersion for full area coverage and uniform lighting and are designed to last 50,000 hours under regular operating conditions. The lights have a IPX7 waterproof rating which means that the unit can be mounted close to the surface for better light penetration and will endure regular water splashing. We would recommend wiping down the unit regularly to ensure optimum lighting.

Each unit has an extendable mounting bracket to fit tanks 61 – 91cm, 91 – 122 cm and 122 – 153 cm respectively.



NOW AVAILABLE IS LED THE **FLUVAL** LAMP TIMER suitable for use with the Aquasky. This will allow you to automate your Aquasky, turning the light on and off and also featuring sunrise,

midday and dusk settings. Progressive dimming options are also available to slowly fade in and fade out lighting on start-up/turn off. The timer can control up to 2 LED lights simultaneously and is, in fact, compatible with any LED with a standard 2.1mm x 5.5mm DC plug connection.

or suspended, and the extendable mounting brackets allow the lights to service a variety of tank sizes. The full spectrum reef lighting includes the essential actinic blue spectrum with 400, 420, 440 and 460nm LEDs for outstanding blue coverage and optimal coral photosynthetic activity, growth and viewing.

This African cichlid originates from Lake Tanganyika and, in the aquarium, grows to around 10cm. It is a graceful fish with beautiful finnage and, unusually, is usually found in schools in its natural environment.

These fish are easy to breed, being substrate spawners, and the entire community, adults and juveniles, will care for the spawn and young, although parents will sometimes eat
