PLASTIC BAG BAN

As you will be aware, a ban on single use plastic bags comes in to force on 1st July. Whilst we will have some compliant plastic bags available, we would encourage you to bring your own carry bags. Alternatively, we have a limited supply of polystyrene boxes which you could keep in your car for transporting fish. An old towel or such like can be used to support the bags and using a box also has the advantage of keeping fish in the dark and thus reduces stress on the way home. Our fish bags, being of thicker plastic, are not subject to this ban and are still the best way to transport fish. We are not able to reuse these due the risk of contamination or leakage, though of course you may choose to reuse them as rubbish bags at home if you so desire.



MARINE FISH OF THE MONTH SILVER SHARKS

Silver Sharks are not a true shark but are so called because of their stream-



lined body and shark-like fins. They are capable of growing up to 30cm, but more commonly reach 15cm unless kept in a very large tank.

They are quite a peaceful fish, especially in view of their size, but should not be trusted with very small fish. These fish do best in a small school. They are very active and a very impressive sight with their metallic silver body and black edged fins and tail. Keep well covered as they are inclined to jump if startled. Normally \$8.99.

FRESHWATER PLANT OF THE MONTH – BLUE STRICTA



Blue Stricta is a hardy bunch plant which makes a great backdrop for lower growing plants. It will grow to the top of the water (and

above) in most aquariums and can be pinched out at the top to encourage growth low down. The colouration will vary from dark green to lime according green to lighting conditions. As with most bunch plants, Blue Stricta grows from a cutting. Although it can be planted in a bunch, good results come from it being separated out and pieces close together, individually. Sleeper Gobies spend their time digging holes in the substrate. If that

doesn't
sound like
a plus,
consider
that whilst
doing so
they sift
the
substrate
(often back
through
their gills)



and remove much of the dirt, uneaten food etc. By turning over the substrate they also inhibit the growth of algae and cyanobacteria.



Gold Head Sleepers are the 'catfish' of the marine world. Sleepers are entertaining to watch in the tank and if kept in pairs, will rarely be far from one another.

Whilst other types of sleepers exist, gold headed sleepers are perhaps the most attractive with their platinum body, gold head and brilliant blue eye stripes. Generally, very peaceful towards other fish, they are reef safe with the proviso that your rockwork is not easily undermined.
